L4	WHEREAS, The Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB or Borough) has vast
L5 L6	stores of natural resources, critical military bases, and tourism as major industries; and
L7	WHEREAS, FNSB is concerned about the safety and conditions of the roads,

20	WHEREAS, Local air quality, land use, education, and transportation are
21	also vital concerns for the FNSB government and its residents; and
22	also vital concerns for the FNSD government and its residents, and
23	WHEREAS, The Borough Assembly has oversight through the exercise of
24	certain powers to address those concerns as development impacts occur in the Borough;

27	WHEREAS, State and Federal proposed actions have direct influence on
28	FNSB government, Borough residents, and visitors; and

30	WHEREAS, The recent U.S. Army Corp of Engineers (ACOE) POA-2013-
31	00286 wetlands permit for Peak Gold, LLC and the Native Village of Tetlin proposes to
32	mine gold near the the Native Village of Tetlin, then haul the ore to Fort Knox for
33	processing to meet global demand ("the Project"); and

34	WHEREAS, The Project and the associated ore transportation would have a direct
35	impact on our residents road travel, recreational uses, and quality of life; and
36	
37	WHEREAS, There has been very limited access to information for our
38	residents on the complete development plans for this proposed mining operation, which
39	includes a major transportation corridor plan that passes over and along major waterways
40	and wetlands areas.
41	
42	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the Fairbanks
43	North Star Borough requests the ACOE extend the public comment period beyond
44	February 13, 2022 for POA-2013-00286.
45	
46	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Assembly requests the ACOE hold at
47	least one public hearing in the FNSB prior to closing the extended public comment period.
48	
49	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Assembly requests the Clerk distribute
50	a copy of this resolution to the ACOE in accordance with the Public Notice for Permit
51	Application.
